Mars is a major corridor crude oil pipeline in a high-growth area of the offshore Gulf of Mexico

- 163-mile pipeline originating approximately 130 miles offshore

Transports production from the Mississippi Canyon area to salt dome caverns in Clovelly, LA

We believe Mars is the primary outlet for connected producers:

- Receives production from the Olympus and Mars platforms the Medusa and Ursa pipelines, and production from other connections
- Well positioned to allow additional connections from new supply pipelines without significant capital expenditures

SPLC operates Mars' pipeline system

- BP holds the remaining minority interest in Mars JV
- SHLX will have voting control of Shell's ownership interest (equal to 71.5%)
